At this time, we are challenging our students to complete at least (2) book reviews during the summer months by either writing the information in their notebook or submitting the reviews electronically.

## Requirements:

## \#1: Complete all (6) weekly math problem solving activities

\#2: Complete at least (3) activities from each reading calendar
\#3: Write/ submit at least (2) book reviews (www.highlandslibrary.com)
